

SCRIPTURAL REFERENCES

Eph 3:10 to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers [*exosia*] in the heavenly *places*.

Eph 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers [*exosia*], against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*

Col 2:15 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers [exosia].

1 *Pet 3:22* who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities [exosia] and powers having been made subject to Him.

DEFINITION

Authority – <u>Webster</u> – Exert energy, force, might. The power of sway or controlling influence over others.

Authority - (Greek) – <u>Ardnt and Gingrich, Greek-English Lexicon</u> – *Exosia (*Greek) – Authority as a freedom of choice, right to act, or decide. It is the ability to do something, capability, might, power to indicate the thing that is to be done.

Dictionary of New Testament Theology: Authority -- The lawful right of action and *unrestrictive* possibility or freedom of action.
