Generational Prayer Model

This is a model ... a basic framework ... not a method

- 1) A dream or a memory – finger to head
- 2) What is the issue – two hands in front
- 3) How many generations back – thumbs pointing back
- 4) Listen to what the Holy Spirit says happened – finger to ear
- 5) Confess, repent, renounce and break the consequences of... - arms crossing repeatedly
- 6) Holy Spirit, come and fill all the places the enemy is vacating and release your blessings – hands arced over head with fingers pointed toward head
