Exploring Heavenly Places Series

Volume 1: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Investigating Dimensions of Healing* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. This introductory book includes articles regarding aspects of the body, soul and spirit, in order to provide a basic understanding of these elements of our humanity.

Volume 2: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Revealing of the Sons of God* by Paul L. Cox and Rob Gross. Our spirits were created before creation in heaven and the name of our spirts is, "sons of God". Some of these created spirits rebelled against God and are attempting to overtake the throne of God. This is the war of the ages. This book explores the scriptural evidence for this battle as well as the believers' part as the revealed sons of God, which are mentioned in Romans 8.

Volume 3: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Gates, Doors and the Grid* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. This volume examines the nature of the multi-dimensional system of universes, focusing mostly on the grid, doors and gates. The evidence presented is clear that when His will is done there (in the heavenly places), our physical existence here (on earth) is the beneficiary of positive change.

Volume 4: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Power in the Heavenly Places* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. This volume explores the multi-faceted nature of the Power of God, including discussions relating to honey, whirlwinds, lightnings of God, the clouds, and the Rainbow Angel.

Volume 5: *Exploring Heavenly Places – The Power of God on Earth as it is in Heaven* of Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. This volume continues to explore the nature of the Power of God. The topics include the tongues of men and of angels, puzzling pieces of God's power, the golden pipes, windows and branches, and the greatest power, which is love.

Volume 6: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Miracles on the Mountain of God* by Rob Gross. Rob Gross, the pastor of Mountain View Community Church in Kaneohe, Hawaii, has utilized the revelation that has come to him and to Aslan's Place, training the people in his church to minister. This book is a compilation of many wonderful stories of the miracles that God has performed in the midst of the people.

Volume 7 – Second Edition: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Discernment Encyclopedia for God's Spiritual Creation* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. The encyclopedia lists the various aspects of God, beings, entities, and spiritual places that can be discerned.

The second edition, published in 2022, contains over twenty new discernment locations.

Volume 8: **Exploring Heavenly Places – Dreamspeak.** Barbara Kain Parker. This book is about the author's personal journey into dream interpretation. It's much more of a this-is-how-God-does-it-with-me account than a one-size-fits-all instruction manual, which hopefully will encourage others to venture out into the heavenly realms of dream exploration.

Volume 9: *Exploring Heavenly Places - Travel Guide to the Width, Length, Depth and Height* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. Ephesians 3:18 expresses that we "may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height." The book examines what happens in these regions and contrasts the differences between the unrighteous and righteous versions of width, length, depth and height.

Volume 10: *Exploring Heavenly Places - A Travelogue of Heavenly Places* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. The authors explore the womb of the dawn, the Order of Melchizedek, the realm of His Majesty, ancient pathways, and the heavenly libraries.

Volume 11: *Exploring Heavenly Places – Strategies for This Present Battle* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. The Bible says we are at war; life confirms that we are at war; so what is our response? Having chosen our side in the oh-so-real conflict between God and His righteousness and justice versus all that is evil; we oppose all that is evil and rebellious in the world. This book is meant to help equip Christians for the battle.

Volume 12: *Exploring Heavenly Places – The Mystery of the Ancient Paths* by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. The solution to the mystery will reveal the secret of a life filled with joy, rest and peace. Biblical insights regarding how our warped perceptions of want, need, lack and expect came to be in the first place are explored. This volume is meant to further equip God's people to persevere and endure within a worldly system that wants nothing more than to snuff out Christianity.

Volume 13: **Exploring Heavenly Places** — **Equipped for Harvest** by Paul L. Cox and Barbara Kain Parker. Volume 14: *Exploring Heavenly Places* — *Discernment 101: A Beginner's Guide to Discernment* by Rob Gross. In the popular tradition of prequels, welcome to this guide that should be a helpful prequel for both the day-to-day quest to delve into the unseen nature of God and the book series that explores those invisible realms. Here you will not only learn in easy-to-understand language exactly what discernment is, but also how to use it to understand how to 'see' what the Father is doing in any given moment; and then cooperate with Him just as Jesus did. He said in John 5:19, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise." Since we are called to be conformed to His image, what a great idea it is to learn how to do that!
